## frequently asked questions

### How do I promote Get a Kick Out of Sharing in my club, school, or church?

Contact World Vision at 1.800.642.1616 for details on how to organize a "Get a Kick Out of Sharing" soccer ball drive.

### What types of soccer balls are needed?

We are looking for donations of new and gently used soccer balls. Sizes 3, 4, and 5 are welcome.

### How can we get the product to you?

Deflated balls should be shipped along with small hand pumps (one for every 10 balls) to either of our distribution centers (see details at bottom left). From these locations they will be shipped to more than 40 countries around the world.

### Can you use other types of soccer gear?

We also accept donations of uniforms in increments of 12. Uniforms should be in good shape and preferably in smaller sizes. Please ship folded and sorted uniforms to a World Vision distribution center (addresses at left).

### Can we send Bible tracts with our soccer balls and uniforms?

Some of the countries where World Vision works do not welcome Christian teachings. To build under-

standing between cultures is an exciting—but delicate—process. Please refrain from sending evangelistic materials, as such communication could alienate and endanger children and World Vision staff members.

### Can I send a personal message along with my donation?

Yes! You are welcome to write a message of encouragement on the balls that you donate. However, please be cautious with religious statements as they could be misunderstood in some cultures.

### Are there locations where balls and uniforms can be dropped off as an alternative to shipping them?

### Besides donating soccer balls, how can I help children in need around the world?

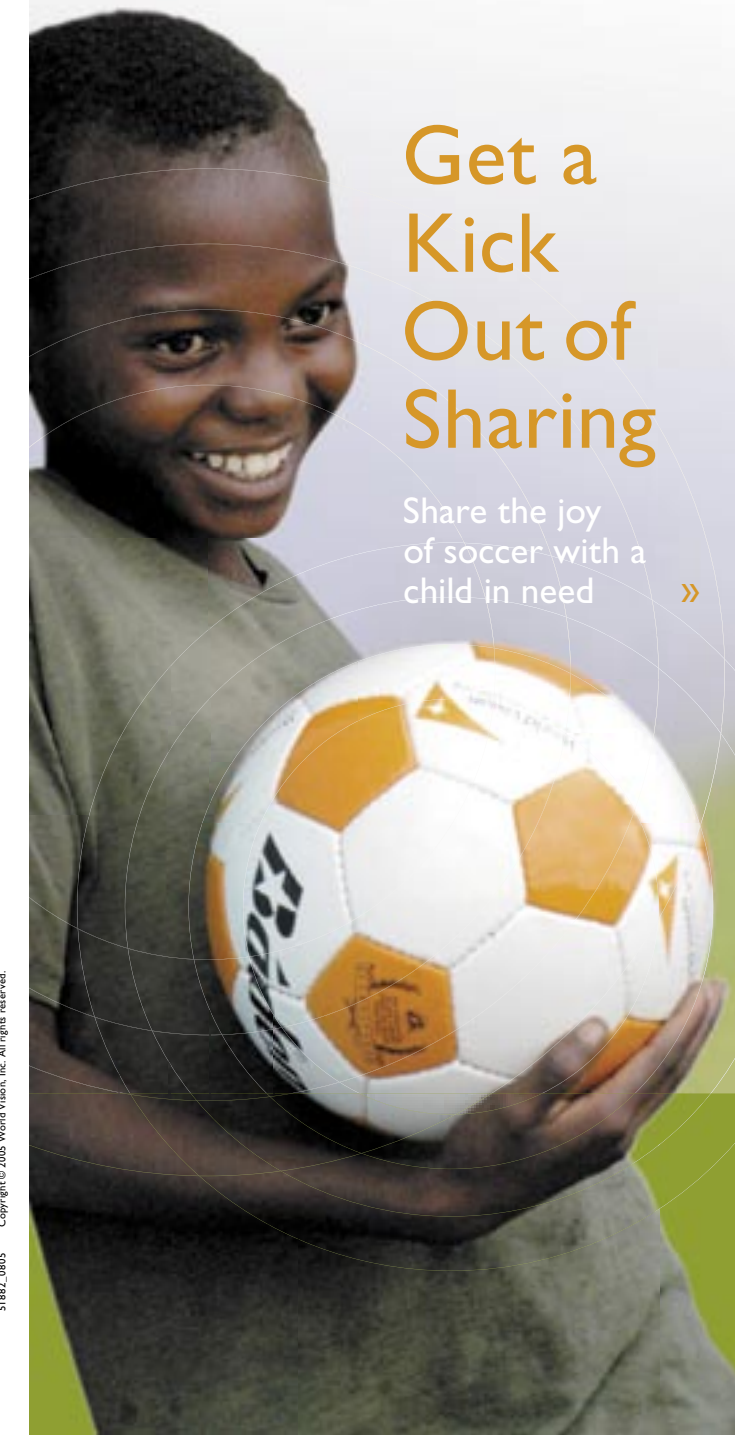
