Special Representative to the President for the HIV/AIDS Hope Initiative, World Vision

Specialty: Effective HIV/AIDS prevention, care, and advocacy programs that are saving lives around the world.

Ken Casey works with governments, humanitarian organizations, and World Vision's offices around the world to reduce the global impact of HIV/AIDS through prevention, care, and advocacy efforts.
